Welcome

The Ship Inn is a traditional free house situated between Hull and Beverley. The Ships Quarters nestles in the grounds of The Ship Inn. It was purpose built in 2006 and has nine en-suite bedrooms, which are all ground level. One is a purpose built twin bedded disabled room, with walk in wet room.

At a Glance

Level Access

- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Bedroom: Room 5
 - Dining Table
 - Beer Garden

Bedrooms

- We have non-allergic bedding.

Level access bedrooms

- The route to the bedroom is 750mm wide, or more.
- The bedroom door is 750mm wide, or more.
- There is unobstructed floor space 1200mm by 900mm, or more.
- The bathroom has a level access shower.

Hearing

- The fire alarm has flashing lights.
- The (bedroom) TVs have subtitles.
- Some staff have disability awareness training.

Visual

- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.

General

- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- Some staff have disability awareness training.
- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to The Ships Quarters by bus.
- There are bus stops in both directions on the main road outside The Ship Quarters approximately 200 meters away. The bus stop is 0.20 miles / 322.0 km from The Ships Quarters.
- You can get a taxi with 60 cars by calling 01482 606060. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.



Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point has a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. There is a permanent ramp.
- The path is sloped.
- The route is 2000mm wide, or more.

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 2000mm wide, or more.
- The path is sloped.



Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The door is 1050mm wide.

Visual Impairment - General Information

- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.



Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights, wall lights and natural daylight.
- Lights are LED and energy saving. TVs have subtitles.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.

- We have non-allergic bedding.
- All bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- We can move the bedroom furniture, to improve accessibility.



Accessible bedrooms

Accessible bedroom Room 5

- From the main entrance to the bedroom, there is level access. There is a ramp. The ramp is Permanent.
- The route to the bedroom is 1300mm wide, or more. The bedroom door is 880mm wide. There is 900mm at the side of the bed. The bed is 650mm high. There is 0mm under the bed.
- The bedroom is twin. The bathroom is ensuite. The bathroom door is 950mm wide.
- The bathroom has a separate shower. The shower has a seat. The shower has a handrail.
- The bathroom has a level access shower. The level access shower has a fixed seat. There is a shower chair. The level access shower has handrails.
- The toilet has handrails. The direction of transfer is to the right. There is 1250mm at the side of the toilet.
- There is 1600mm in front of the toilet. The toilet seat is 500mm high.
- The basin is 650mm high. There is space under the basin, with no pedestal.
- The bathroom has an emergency call system.
- The walls and the bathroom fittings have high colour contrast.



Place to eat and drink

The Ship Inn

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. The route is 1300mm wide, or more. The door is 1050mm wide.
- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music sometimes.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for vegetarian and gluten free (celiacs) specific diets.

Getting around outside

Beer Garden

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. There is a permanent ramp. The route is 1300mm wide, or more. The entrance is 880mm wide.

Accessibility equipment

- Assistance dogs are allowed to use the grounds.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
- Please ask a member of staff.

- You can hire mobility equipment from Age Uk by calling 01482 324644.

Emergency evacuation procedures

- We have emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors.
- The fire alarm has flashing lights.

Customer care support

- Some staff have disability awareness training.
- Staff are available 24 hours a day.
- The Owners live on site.
